# THIRD SUNDAY in ORDINARY TIME

Gospel:

Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21

Luke portrays Jesus as One who had a clear understanding of who he

was and his mission. Who he was: the One "in the power of the Spirit." His mission: "to bring glad tidings" to the poor, captives, blind, oppressed. Luke also had a clear understanding of who he was and his mission: he investigated "everything accurately anew" in order to proclaim the Good News. From the very beginning, what Jesus came to fulfill has been observed, treasured, handed down. Now we ourselves are to be the bearers of the Good News so that others may "realize the certainty" of the story we have received.


