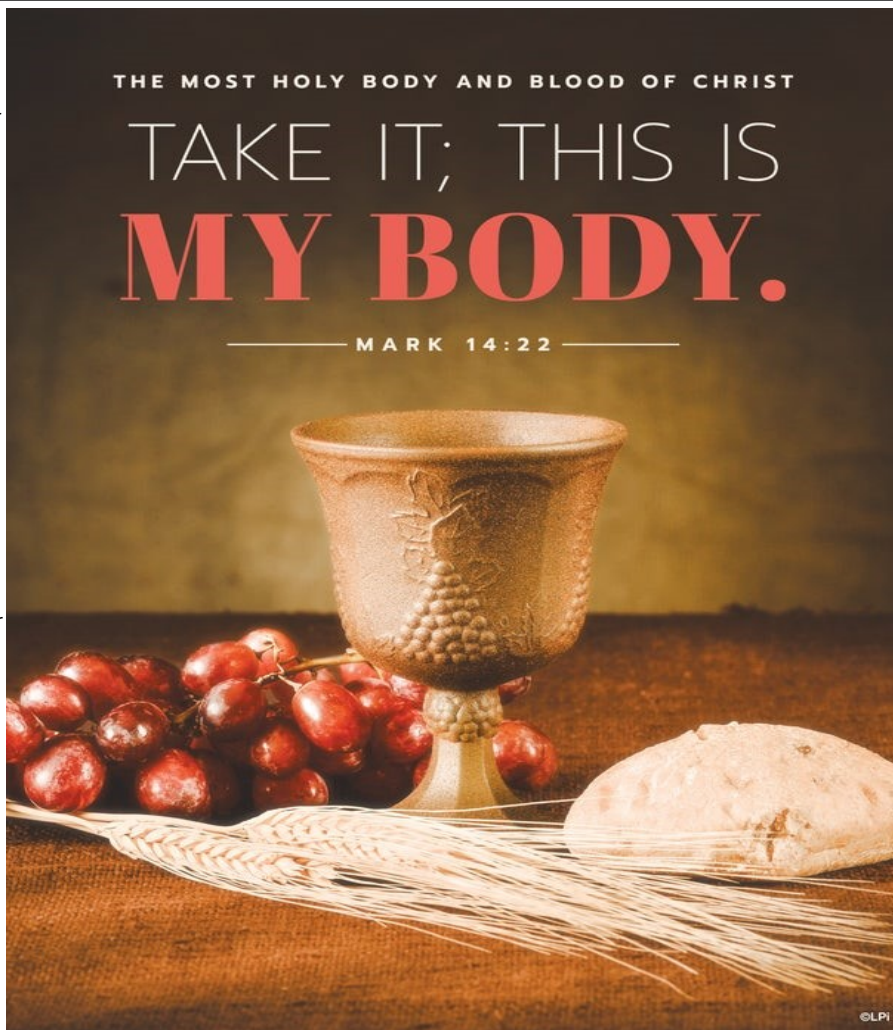

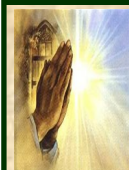

Gospel: Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

Christ came from the kingdom of heaven and yet was of the world. Therefore he achieved for us the perfect unity of heaven and earth. Christ freely choose to be sacrificed out of love, on our behalf.

So, on the night before he suffered Jesus gave his disciples sacramental signs of what would be fulfilled the next day: he handed them his Body and Blood under the appearance of bread and wine. He told them to consume it. Thus it became a re-presentation for all time of His sacrifice on the cross.

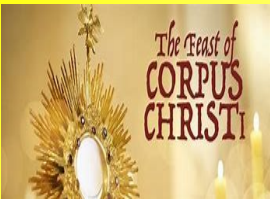
