

Gospel: <u>Luke</u> 18:9-14

Pharisees were held in high esteem in Jewish culture. Tax

collectors, on the other hand, were collaborators with the Romans. They also cheated people to increase their earnings. So they were despised. So for Jesus to tell this story where the Pharisee is the "villain" and the tax collector is the "hero" is a complete reversal of how these roles were perceived. Jesus is showing us that it is not social status which matters in the eyes of God. He cares about how our hearts are oriented. We must remember that everything we are and have comes from God. And we are all in need of God's mercy. When we start thinking that praying and following the rules somehow earn us a special place in the Kingdom of God, then we are relying on our own efforts instead of




ANOINTING MASSES,
