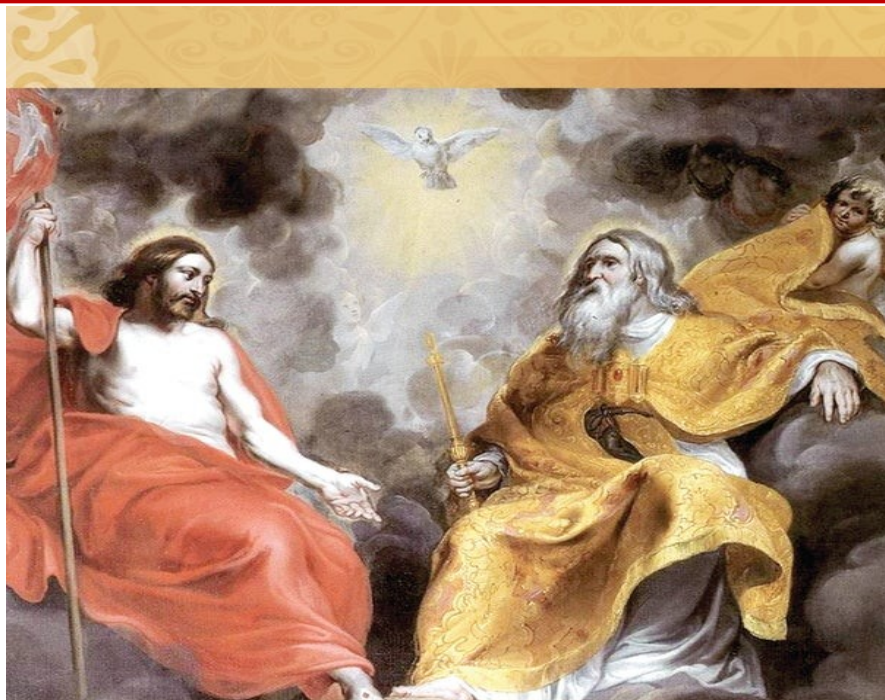

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

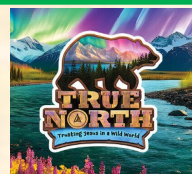
Gospel: John 16:12-15
