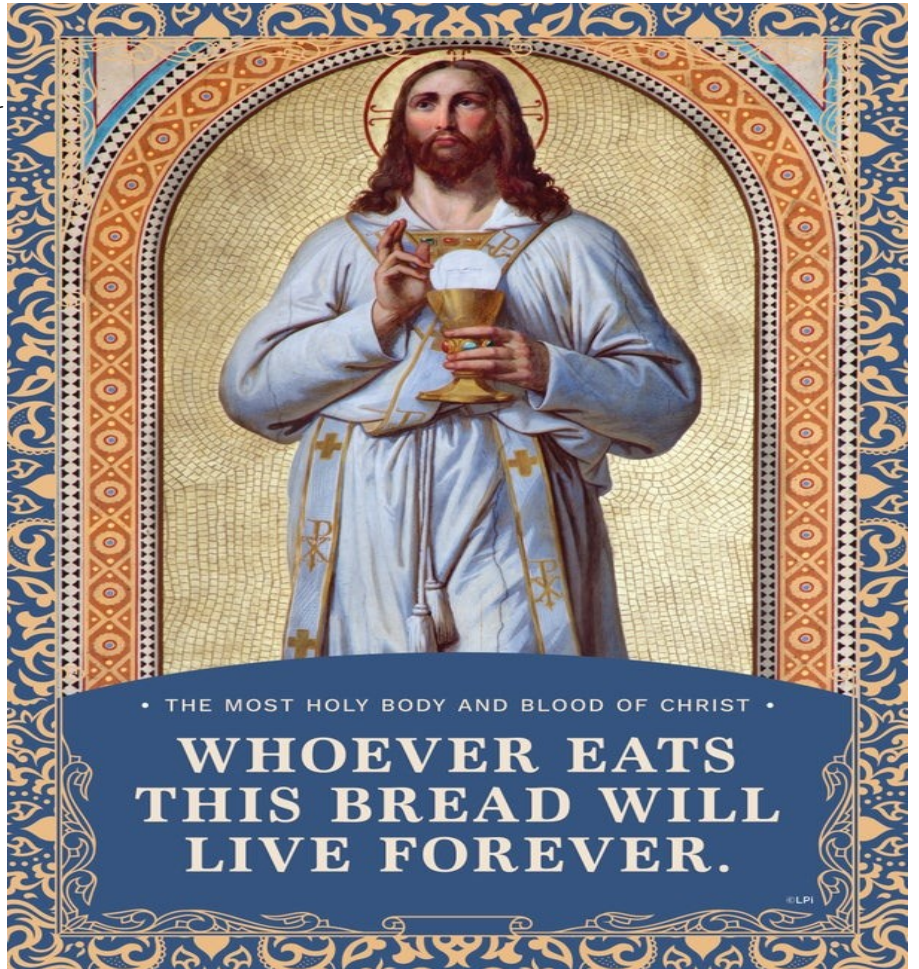

THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Today is Corpus Christi, the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. At the conclusion of the Easter season we focus on the extreme importance of Christ's Body and Blood. This is our Lifeblood! At Adoration and Benediction you're right in front of the Lord Jesus himself, present in the Eucharist! And you'll receive a plenary indulgence and special graces! All of this helps you on the way to heaven! At 9:00 AM we will have a Solemn Mass in honor of The Holy Sacrament. All are asked to participate in the outdoor Eucharistic Procession of the Blessed Sacrament, around the outside of the church, along with St. Mark's Fourth Degree of The Knights of Columbus. After returning to the church through the middle aisle, we will be placing the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance on the altar. Then a Holy Hour will commence for private adoration. At 11:15 AM, we will have Benediction the Most Blessed Sacrament. If you do not attend the 9:00 AM Mass, please come for some of the adoration and for the benediction at 11:15 AM of the Blessed Sacrament.
