

Gospel: John 6:1-15

What answer did Philip need to give Jesus to

pass the test? When Jesus asks about where to buy food to satisfy the hunger of the large crowd, he is not thinking about a store and purchases. He is really asking a question about who he is. Jesus knows full well that the "where" of the food will be himself. The superabundance of food Jesus provides from so little is a sign of the fullness of Life his very self—Jesus gives. So, Philip's answer? "Give them vourself."
