
Adult: When have you most felt like a hypocrite? How did you overcome this feeling?

Gospel: Luke 6:39-45

This Gospel ends with "From the goodness of the heart the mouth speaks." How does Pope Francis say we can get to that point? "The fruitfulness of our life depends on prayer," he stated, explaining that in prayer we can ask Jesus for the gift of seeing the world with his eyes. This way, he said, we can "love our brothers and sisters, starting from the poorest and those who suffer the most, as he did, and to love them with his heart and to bring to the world fruits of goodness, fruits of charity, and fruits of peace."
